Other

1. A Maximum of 2% of other Grains or Soybeans
2. Corn that is found to be musty, sour, or containing a commercially objectionable foreign odor (COFO) will be discounted 10 cents/bushel, or may be rejected. Corn must meet all FDA and/or USDA fumigation requirements.
3. Corn containing 2 or more live weevils or 10 or more other live grain storage insects per sample will be discounted 5 cents per bushel.
4. Aflatoxin levels over 10ppb (parts per billion) will be rejected.
5. Corn containing rodent or bird contamination, stones, glass or other commercially undesirable foreign material will be rejected.
6. Official grades can be requested at the time of the unload at the producer's expense. OFFICIAL GRADES TO GOVERN.
7. Excessive snow and or ice will be rejected

Additional Charges:

1. South Dakota Corn Check-off of 1 cent/bushel will be deducted.
