

Dry Distillers Grain with Solubles

Dakota Ethanol has been in operation since 2001. Our products are tested on a load by load basis for Protein, Fat, Moisture and Color. Toxins are tested for on a routine basis to ensure the feed quality. Also, samples are sent to outside labs to ensure our testing results are accurate. Samples are retained.

Dried Distillers Grain with Solubles (DDGS) is the remainder of the corn kernel after the starch is removed during the process of making ethanol. The wet feed product is dried using large drum driers and the syrup product with solubles is added on to the feed while being dried. The finished product; DDGS moisture averages 9% to ensure flowability is transferred to upright or flat storage. Dakota Ethanol has the ability to load any size truck or wagon as well as rail car capabilities.

DDGS is a good source of protein that can be a replacement of both concentrates and forages. Also, with the high energy content it can be used for lactating cows, growing and finishing cattle. Dry Distillers has been successfully fed at inclusion rates of 40% dry matter for beef cattle and easily 20% dry matter inclusion for dairy cattle. Numerous studies have been performed by several accredited Universities such as South Dakota State University, University of Nebraska, University of Iowa and University of Minnesota.
